Academic Scholarship

Academic Scholarships are available to students entering Year 5, 7 and 10 at the beginning of the school year and will apply for the duration of the student's time in their relevant sub-School:

Primary School	(Years 5-6)
Junior Secondary	(Years 7-9)
Upper Secondary	(Years 10-12)

Academic Scholarship applicants will be required to sit the academic test which is provided by a national testing body and is used to identify academically able students for the award of a scholarship. The test is not based on the school curriculum or the ability to retrieve learned information. Instead it is designed so that applicants are required to demonstrate skills in areas such as the ability to interpret, infer, deduce and think critically.

This scholarship provides up to 50% reduction of tuition fees and is awarded annually to the highest achieving student in each applicable entry level who meets the academic criteria. The scholarship requires ongoing acceptable academic achievement which will be reviewed annually.

Who can apply:

This scholarship is open to current Court Grammar School students as well as potential future students. Students in Year 4, 6 and 9 in 2020 can apply to sit the academic testing for 2021 entry.

Arts Academy

Our amazing new Arts Academy offers students the opportunity to be taught by specialist teachers in the fields of Visual & Digital Art (Visual Arts, Photography and Media), and Musical Theatre (Music, Drama and Dance), all in the surrounds of our brand new state-of-the-art Arts Centre.

Arts Scholarships are available to students entering Year 5, 7 and 10-12 at the beginning of the school year and will apply for the duration of the student's time in their relevant sub-School:

Primary School (Years 5-6)

Junior Secondary (Years 7-9)

Upper Secondary (Years 10-12)

Scholarship and Academy acceptance is awarded to students demonstrating technical skill and an inherent interest in developing through the Arts. Talented candidates are invited to apply, with scholarships being awarded to the student demonstrating the highest ability in the above-mentioned fields at each entry level. Scholarships can be achieved in 3 categories:

Category A: 50% fee reduction

AFL/W Academy

Our extremely popular and successful AFL/W Academy offers students the opportunity to be taught by specialist teachers, coaches and players during school contact time with the aim of growing their passion for AFL and developing them into elite footballers.

Academy entry and Scholarship opportunities are available to students entering Year 5, 7 & 10-12 at the beginning of the school year and will apply for a minimum of 2 years from the year of scholarship commencement.

Entry into the Academy is based on a tryout process and students are ranked according to their performance. Scholarships are awarded to the highest achieving players on the day, depending on the number of scholarships available for their year level. The results of the tryouts also allow students who perform at a suitable level to gain a place in the academy without gaining fee reduction.

This scholarship is awarded in 3 categories in each applicable year group:

- Category A: 50% fee reduction
- Category B: 25% fee reduction
- Category C: No fee reduction, acceptance into Academy

The continuation of this scholarship and placement in the Academy is subject to acceptable achievement and positive contribution to the ethos of the school, including a commitment to the co-curricular program. This is reviewed on an annual basis.

Nijole Natalija Weedon Bursary - Indigenous Students

This bursary provides up to \$5,000 fee assistance for student fees per year to an indigenous or refugee student commencing at Court Grammar School in any of the Secondary School years 7-12. Further, the bursary seeks to provide for a child who would normally not be able to attend Court Grammar School and be able to pursue the academic opportunities available in the School.

Applicants are required to have an interview, with their family, conducted by the School Principal.

This bursary is offered to one (1) student for the duration of their secondary schooling and is not available to any other student until such time as the recipient graduates or leaves the School.

The continuation of this assistance is subject to acceptable academic achievement and positive contribution to the ethos of the school and is up to the discretion of the Principal. This is reviewed on an annual basis.

Who can apply:

This scholarship is open to current Court Grammar School students as well as potential future students. This bursary has been awarded and the next one is ONLY available from 2025. Students in Year 6, 2024 can apply for 2025 entry.

 - c. Any other supporting documentation*
 - d. Application fee \$95 (per Academic and New Student Scholarship)*
- iv) Successful application does in no way bind the School to granting a scholarship to younger siblings in later years. It is to be noted that younger siblings enrolled at Court Grammar School receive normal family discounts.*
- v) Failure to meet satisfactory standards of achievement may result in the Scholarship or Bursary being withdrawn.*
- vi) Failure of the successful applicant or his/her parents to adhere to the conditions of enrolment, ie: ensuring that the student wears the full school uniform, upholding the published rules of the school, supporting the Christian philosophy of the School, and participating in School activities, may result in the Scholarship or Bursary being withdrawn.*
- vii) Applicants cannot hold more than one scholarship/bursary at any given time. In the instance where an applicant is awarded a scholarship/bursary and already holds one, the higher value scholarship/bursary will apply.*
