### COVID Update Number 2/2022 – 7 February 2022

1. Thank you for returning our students to us! Given everything going on we are delighted with the **smooth start** to the year.
2. The 2 staff members we were awaiting permission to enter WA have **now arrived** and will commence work on Monday 21 February.
3. Please be advised that we DO NOT have a never-ending stock of **masks** for students. They should all have a spare with them in case their straps snap. Mr. Brad Krokosz has a few and we will be **fund raising for Anglicare at a gold coin** donation! Let's see how much we can raise. I would prefer the amount to be nil in this instance!
4. We had a very limited number of year groups and only the parents of student leaders at our **Sir Charles Court Futures Assembly**. As the Police Commissioner, Chris Dawson, was unable to attend in person he sent us a superb oration on **Respect for Self, our theme for 2022**. This will be on our website this week for you to listen to as well.
5. We have commenced **limiting** the number of indoor crossover events with multiple year groups.
6. The **Arts Academy** classes after school will be going ahead as planned for those students involved.
