- TIME:** 8.30am Arrival for a 9:00am START.
- EVENT:** This event is a House challenge held as an equestrian gymkhana competition. Only Serpentine Jarrahdale Grammar School students are eligible to enter. Students are not required to hold any equestrian insurance to compete, although it is encouraged.
- SUMMARY:** For every event completed you will gain points for you and your House. Ribbons placed to sixth for each class. High point and Runner up Medallions will be awarded for each year group.
- SPECTATORS:** Un-mounted/non riding student helpers are welcome but must be accompanied by an adult and sign a disclaimer. Un-mounted/non riding student helpers will also gain points for their House.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

DRESSAGE

Riders to choose one test. Please ride to your ability. Tests on offer are

- Preparatory B (Leading Rein and First Ridden are eligible for this test)
- Preliminary 1.1 ○ Preliminary 1.3 ○ Novice 2.2
- (2014 tests apply See EWA Website for current tests)

NOVELTIES (Open to all riders including the Leading Rein and First Ridden)

- Dueling Dragons – team event, against the clock.
Two rows of jumping and bending mirror image set up as House versus House (see attached diagram)
- Fire Breathing Barrels - individual
- The Flying Sack Race- individual
- Dragon Egg and Spoon Race – team event
- Flapping Tail Flag Race – team event
- How to Train your Dragon Fancy Dress - individual
- Jackpot Dragon Joker; individual show jumping event, starting at 45cm. Each obstacle has a point value allocated and riders must gain the most points by jumping fences within a 90sec time limit – individual event.

SHOWJUMPING:

Students may choose two consecutive heights and classes will be run as a AM7 Competition

- 45cm
- 65cm
- 80cm
- 95cm

SHOW MAN CLASSES

RING 1 – Showjumping

Jumping height will be 45cm; 65cm, 80cm and 95cm. Riders choose the height according to your ability. We will start the jumping section at 45cm.

RING 2 – Ridden arena – Ridden workouts

RING 3 – In hand arena

Riders will move through each ring from 1 to 3. Winners are taken from the highest combined scores from each phase.

You may only choose one showjumping height for the Showman Classes. If you do not want to jump as part of the Showman classes you will be allocated a base point score. Workouts will be available through the entry package prior to the event.



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CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Dress standards – House shirt over the top of a white long sleeved shirt, cream, beige, fawn or navy jodhpurs ○ Riders **MUST** compete in House colours and in their relevant year group.
- Smooth soled boots; chaps/gaiters optional. All riders must wear safety approved helmets.
- Safety vest/body protectors are encouraged. ○ Gear Checking will be carried out under PCAWA guidelines. Please check the PCAWA Website.
- Plaiting of horses is optional ○ All hay and manure must be removed from the ground at the completion of the event. Please bring your own Manure Scoops and chaff bags to assist with the cleanup. ○ No ALCOHOL to be consumed on the grounds. ○ No DOGS on the grounds.
- No SMOKING on the grounds
- Competitors are asked not to approach the judges during the events. If you have any queries please speak with a school official. Judges decisions are final.
- Please ensure that you close the gate on both entry and especially on leaving the grounds.
- All riders must have a parent/guardian on the grounds for the duration of the day.
- All riders must nominate a helper for the day, time slots for helper duties will be allocated
- Draws for competition times and helper duties will be available one week prior to the event.
- The organizing committee of Serpentine Jarrahdale Grammar School Gymkhana reserves the right to cancel, alter or combine any events they deem necessary.
- Leading Rein and First Ridden classes are open to those students who may ride on the lead or are just off the lead. All ponies must be lead from cavesson noseband or a halter correctly fitted beneath the bridle.


